ORDER:-

In the reference 1<sup>st</sup> read above, the Government have introduced “Indiramma Amrutha Hastham” for spot feeding of one full meal for Pregnant & Lactating women at Anganwadi Centres (AWCs) from 1<sup>st</sup> January 2013. This new intervention is introduced in 102 ICDS Projects which had the most adverse health and nutrition indicators for covering 1/4<sup>th</sup> of Pregnant & Lactating women in the State.

2. In the reference 3<sup>rd</sup> read above, the Commissioner, Women Development & Child Welfare Department, Hyderabad has reported that “Indiramma Amrutha Hastham” programme is being implemented satisfactorily and that the response from the target group is over-whelming. He has also stated that to have a more significant and sustainable impact particularly to improve maternal nutrition and reduce incidence of low birth weight the programme may be extended to cover at least 1/3<sup>rd</sup> of the Pregnant and Lactating women in the State. He has therefore proposed to implement the programme additionally in about 50 ICDS Projects which have high IMR, MMR and Malnutrition.

3. After careful examination of the proposal of the Commissioner, Women Development & Child Welfare Department, Hyderabad, the Government hereby accords permission for expansion of “Indiramma Amrutha Hastham” in the State to another 63 ICDS Projects based on adverse health & nutrition indicators. The list of these 63 ICDS Projects with details of number of AWCs and estimated number of Pregnant & Lactating women is at Annexure appended to this G.O.

4. The operational guideline issued under reference 2<sup>nd</sup> read above, and other guidelines issued from time to time with regard to implementation of “Indiramma Amrutha Hastham” shall be followed scrupulously in implementation of the programme in the 63 ICDS Projects.
